

## **OUTLINE OF A SCHOOL VISIT DAY**

Coach arrives and disembarks opposite the museum. A costumed guide greets and warns students they are about to walk up historic cobblestones—"no running!"	Costume guides introduce themselves and the school is split into groups (depending on size of school party) for each activity, lasting approximately 30 minutes each.  Carousel of two workshops and guided tour of museum.	Packed lunches can be eaten in covered courtyard area. (Large groups will have half the pupils taken to a local room). If a nice day, there is the option of the park at the bottom of the road (overlooking the River Avon).	William Shake- speare himself will take the group through his beautiful home town of Stratford upon Avon, regaling the pupils with tales of his life, work and 16th century.	The finish time depends on the time the group arrived in the morning (i.e. if they were delayed) and the size of the group. The day will end no later than 3pm.	Time for overrun or to buy a small souvenir in the museum gift shop.
